

Dear Friends,

we are finally glad to give you further information about the **“EMAF – European Masters Athletics Festival for silver age”**.

As you already know, we are going to stage an international indoor event dedicated to the Master athletes with specific attention to the age-categories starting from 60 years old (M60 for men and W60 for women) and over. The athletes, divided into categories based on age, will compete in a selection of indoor athletics events. As you can see in the attached program, we therefore foreseen competitions of all groups of events: running, both sprint and middle distance, jumping (long, triple), throwing (shot put) and race walking.

The official scheduled dates are: **Tuesday 14th to Sunday 19th April 2020**. Arrivals and Departures will be respectively on Tuesday and Sunday. All the days will be dedicated to very interesting and focused Workshops and Conferences. The competition days will start on Thursday and end on Saturday. For any doubts, you can consult the draft daily timetable attached.

Regarding the financial conditions, we are really happy to inform you that the LOC, thanks to the grant received by EU for our awarded project, will cover travel, transfers and accommodation costs for 9 athletes and 1 Team Leader per Country. Costs of any out-of-quota athletes and additional accompanying person will be covered by the visiting Federation.

For registration into the event, we will be asking you to register your athletes using our form, which will be sent to you after your confirmation of participation to the EMAF.

Furthermore, a kick-off press conference will be held before the end of the year. Afterwards, we will send to you the press release that we would ask you to share through your website and any other communication channel.

Finally we are kindly asking you for a final confirmation of your participation to the project at your earliest convenience, but by 16/12/2019 at latest.
